



## Wildwood Park Pedestrian Bridge Saratoga, California

### Civil and Structural Engineering



Mesiti-Miller Engineering was the prime design consultant responsible for the design of this 70 foot main span glu-lam timber bridge with more than 100 feet of associated ADA compliant ramps and stairways.

Because the bridge connects the natural park with the quaint village of Saratoga, its design demanded an aesthetically pleasing and rustic design in full compliance with ADA accessibility requirements.

The bridge and all appurtenances were designed to fit amongst and blend in with the native trees lining the creek. Careful attention to detail during design combined with diligent follow up during construction resulted in the successful realization of a beautiful public project, carefully integrated into both the natural park setting and the rustic downtown village.
